### By Air:

- Murtala Muhammed International Airport (LOS) is the primary entry point into Lagos, serving both local and international flights.
- Airlines with major routes include: Air Peace, Ibom Air, Ethiopian Airlines, Qatar Airways, British Airways, and Turkish Airlines.

### Visa Requirements:

- Most African nationals can apply for a Visa on Arrival (VoA) or e-Visa.
- International participants should contact the Nigerian embassy or visit [www.immigration.gov.ng](http://www.immigration.gov.ng) for guidance.
- LDNI can issue invitation letters upon request to support visa applications.

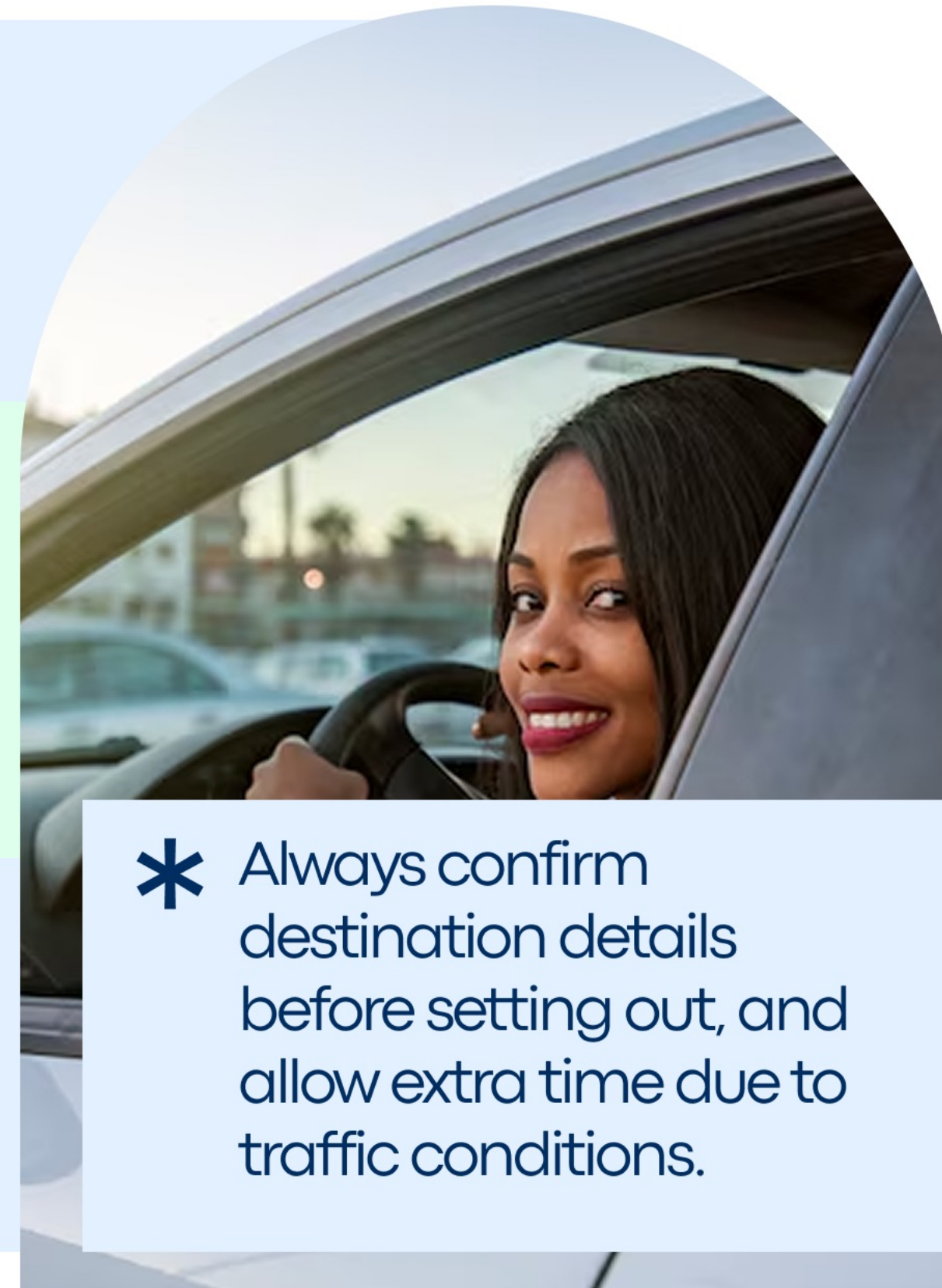
